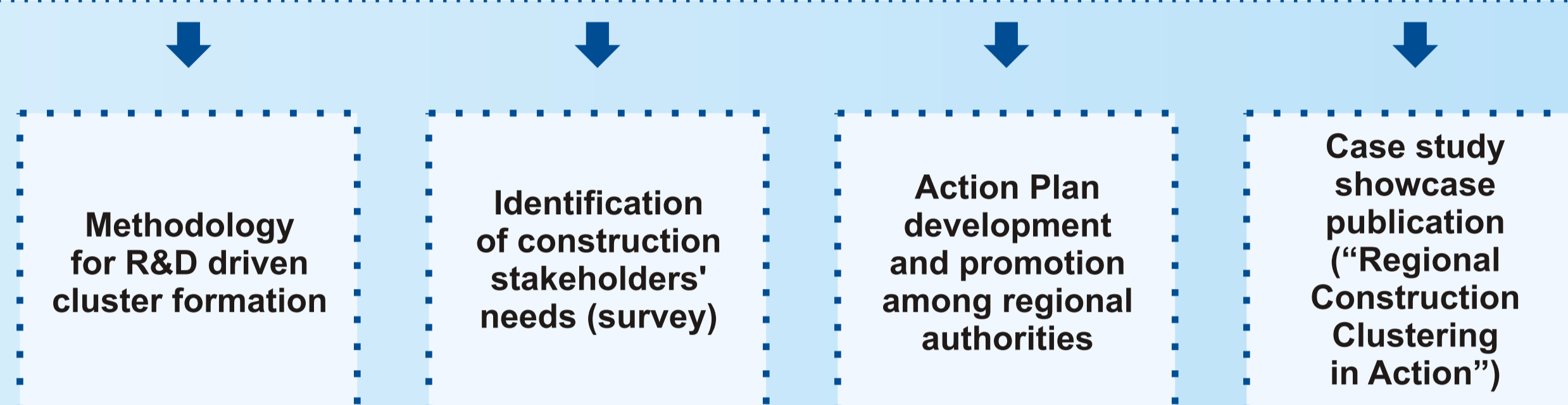

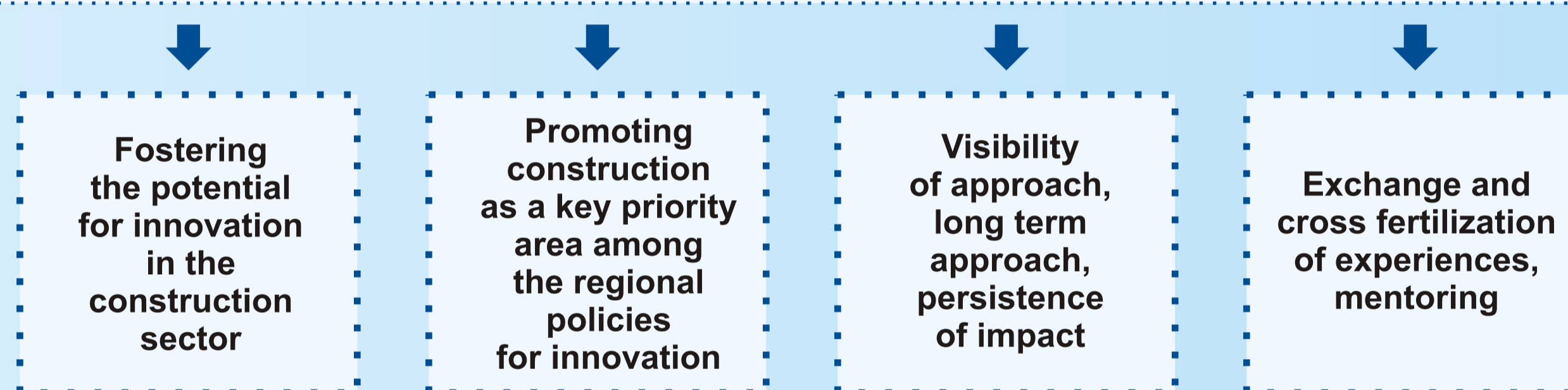
## ABOUT
